## **Fast Track to Graduation**

**You have worked really hard and now is the time to start thinking about how to complete the requirements needed for your High School Diploma.**

*The following steps are needed for you to be successful.*

1. Meet with your Project Manager to review your plan of work.
2. You have until May 8th to reach 17 Credits in order to be eligible to walk in the 2016 Ceremony. You will have until August 31st to complete all 18 Credits for your diploma.
3. Sign the Commitment Pledge that states that you will work hard to complete ALL High School requirements by August 31, 2016.
4. You WILL NOT receive the official diploma the day of the ceremony. Please meet with your Project Manager to complete the final exit process for graduation. (Diplomas will not be ordered until you are officially completed with all credit requirements.) Diplomas take 4 to 6 weeks from when they are ordered to be delivered to the school.
5. Meet with Emilia Kozak or Jordan Ewert to be part of the Graduation Video ASAP. We would like ALL researchers represented in some way. If you do not want your video taken that is ok. You can always write a message or words of advice.
6. Check PowerSchool often.
7. Contact Jamie Jefferson at 313-565-0288 with any questions about the Graduation process.

**Cap & gown money is due on May 10th**


